**COURT OF THE DISTRICT COLLECTOR**  
**WEST CHAMPARAN**

**ORDER**

1 This appeal has been filed against the order of District Programme Officer, ICDS, West Champaran vide letter no 670 dated 12.12.2011 whereby the selection of appellant Neelima devi w/o Arun Kumar as anganwaadi sevika of Centre No. 03, Badhayi Tola of Banuchhapar Panchayat, Bettiah was terminated.

2. Heard all concerned and perused all the documents on record.

3. The appellant submits that her centre was inspected thrice by CDPO, Bettiah and reported irregularity to DPO, West Champaran who terminated her selection without giving an opportunity to be heard.

4. She further submits that she filed written complaint before SDO Bettiah on 22.11.11, before DPO on 23.11.11 and a complaint on affidavit to the District Collector on 24.11.11 stating that the CDPO, Bettiah was demanding illegal gratification. Based on the complaint, the DDC was directed to conduct an enquiry, which is still pending.

5. The appellant and CDPO, Bettiah were directed to file their written replies. Senior Officer in charge of ICDS, Vinod Kumar was directed to verify the documents filed by the appellant.

6. The CDPO, Bettiah submits the centre was inspected on 19.10.11, 20.11.11 and 22.11.11. Only 17, 30 and zero children were found during these inspections. THR was not being distributed on 22.11.11, no registers were shown and that the sevika misbehaved with her. She reported this to DPO vide letter no 321 dated 22.11.11.

The DPO, West Champaran issued showcause to appellant vide letter no 10 dated 22.11.11 itself. DPO records that the sevika refused to accept the notice and terminated the selection on 12.12.11.

7. The Senior Officer in charge ICDS , Vinod Kumar submitted his report vide letter no 233 dated 9.4.12 in which he verified all the records submitted by the Appellant and the records of CDPO and DPO. The following irregularities were pointed out.

- a. The register was maintained from October 2010 and has entries for November 10, June 2011 and September 11.
- b. That except for 22.11.11, no quantity of dry ration distributed was recorded in the register.
- c. Certain entries in the record were found against which no receiving recorded.
- d. On 22.11.11 distribution was recorded with signatures of adhyaksh, member of posahar samiti and sevika.

8. The DPO did issue a show cause but the sevika is said to have refused to accept it. Enquiry into the complaint of sevika is pending.

9. In the light of above facts, I consider it prudent to revoke the termination order of DPO, West Champaran with immediate effect. I also direct the appellant to receive the showcause notice issued by the DPO and file her reply to the same. The records submitted along with the appeal petition and findings of the Senior - in-charge along with anyother submissions made shall be duly considered by the DPO without any prejudice. The matter shall be disposed off by DPO, West Champaran within one month. The appellant shall continue to function as Sevika of the Centre No. 03 of Badhayi tola, Banuchappar until final disposal.

10. I direct DDC, Bettiah to complete the enquiry regarding complaint made against the CDPO, Bettiah within 10 days.

Send a copy of this order to CDPO Bettiah, DPO, West Champaran and DDC, Bettiah for compliance.
